## ZUMBA SESSION *and* MARATHON

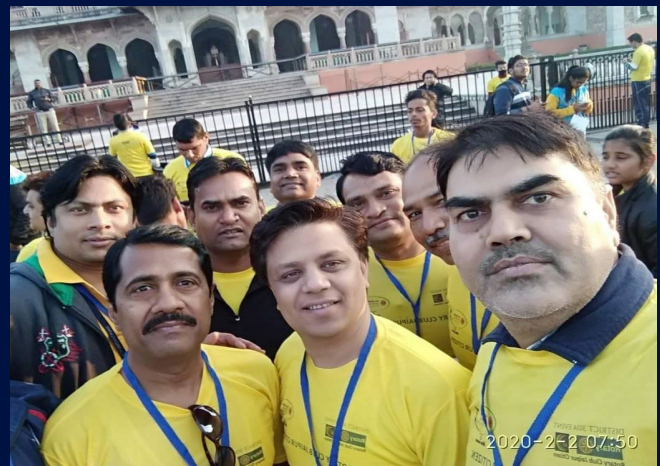

## VOTERS DAY

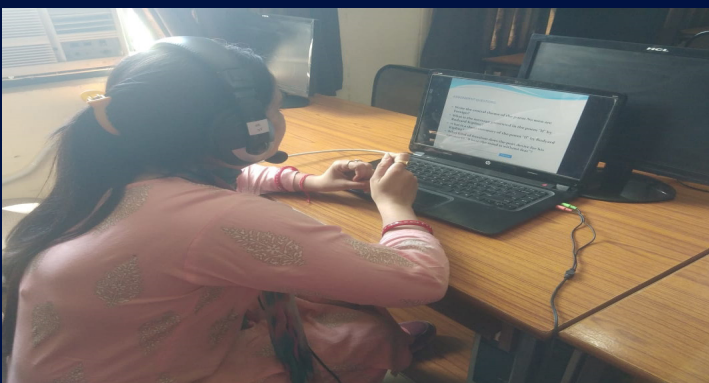
