15. Special programmes conducted by the department for advanced learners and slow learners:

The institute has designed a well-defined system to discover various levels of diversity of the students and their performance as well. The institution assesses the learning levels of the students in two ways at the time of the commencement of the programme. Students enrolled in various disciplines are identified on the basis of their +2 marks and rank in entry level test as slow and advanced learners. This helps to identify the slow learners and to design special programme to bridge the gap between the slow learners and the advanced learners. The faculty members of the respective classes extend valid support in classifying the students with the aid of continuous internal assessment based on the achievement of the set target of CO attainment in unit tests, internal examination, and practical examinations. Those students who fail to achieve the set target of CO attainment are slow learners. Remedial classes are conducted to improve the academic performance of slow learners.

In addition to this, extra efforts have been made for slow learners like providing additional (Revision) study material, assignments, discussion of previous years University questions papers and viva-voce. After that, reassessment has been carried out to access the improvement of the students. If the targets are not achieved after reassessment then counseling sessions are carried out to motivate them towards their improvement in academics. Students who are identified as advanced learners are encouraged to participate and present papers in various seminars/conferences/workshops. They are also encouraged to participate in inter-college and



intra-college curricular and co-curricular activities, lab, institute events, and organizing committee.

They are also motivated to participate in project developments, start-ups, and incubation centre activities. Certificates have been awarded to meritorious students of the department from every semester.
