1. Minutes of the meeting dated 30/05/2018 was read by the Member Secretary and it was confirmed and approved by the members unanimously.

2. Action Taken of Previous meeting dated 30/05/2018

- a. Based on the last minutes of meeting, member secretary informed that accreditation for three branches viz., Computer Science & Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering was applied and the visit was held during November 16-18, 2018. He informed that two programs were accredited by the National Board of Accreditation, New Delhi viz., Mechanical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering for three years i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.
- b. It was informed that Program Coordinators/HODs are utilizing their impressed amount of Rs. 10,000/- as informed by the Accounts Office (impressed amount re-sanctioned on submission of expenditure statement).
- c. As per the point 'f' of meeting dated 30/05/2018 value added courses are delivered to the students through registered training centers.
- d. Member secretary informed that we have applied research grants from the Government agencies for conducting the different activities.
- e. As per the point 'i' of meeting dated 30/05/2018, students are given training in the area of AI, Machine Learning and Python, due to which they are able to present their Humanoid and expenditure on the same is Approx. Rs. 5,00,000/- is provided by the institute under R&D budget.
- f. As per the point 'j' efforts are made to improve the QIV rating at RTU, Kota for the year 2019-2020. This year score is 878 points with respect to last year 740 points.
- g. Member secretary present the action taken report and it was approved by the all members unanimously.

Further Planning

- Incubation activities are to be increased at the campus and separate space to be allocated for the same.
- Centre of excellence are to be established in the area of Automation / R&D for Mechanical students.
- Accreditation of other branches to be applied
- Faculty cadre is to be improved

Further discussions –

Member secretary shared the following information to the board –

- a. that up-gradation of College library is taking care of, in the previous year 2018-19 as per RTU syllabus 93 books of 15 titles were procured and order placed for 477 books for the next session.
- b. that faculty members are motivated to register for Ph.D. and four faculty members Shri Mukesh Agarwal, Shri Gajendra Sharma, Shri Amit Mithal, Ms. Priyanka Shukla took admission in Ph.D. program from reputed universities. Some more are in pipe line.
- c. that students are taking participation in different activities outside the campus also some of them are – Smart India Hackathon, Smart Business Hackathon, Old age home visit, Welding competition in Welding league of women student held at Bhuvneshwar, various sports activities etc.
- d. that continuous efforts are being made to improve QIV rating at RTU, Kota. He also shared that in the previous year we were at 6<sup>th</sup> position.
- e. Talks related to Centre of Excellence in the area of Automation & Robotics is initiated.
- f. Python training through student club is initiated
- g. R&D activity club has been established named as Stargent, wherein students from all programs are selected for R&D activities.
- h. Incubation centre is established and funded by the Government of Rajasthan. At present 10 (Ten) incubation centers are in function at the Campus.
- i. Efforts are being made to establish industry supported labs.
- j. Students are getting paid internships through AICTE Internshala program and 42 students got paid internships through Internshala.
- k. Efforts are being made for additional facility in the program/department. New equipments on latest technology are to be procured so that students will get the additional knowledge. He informed that all Program/departments are in the process of submitting budget for the same.

- l. It was discussed that faculty members are appreciated for their efforts to uplift of quality of education through a 200 points criteria. In which faculty members are required to provide information related to their R&D activities, innovation in teaching methodology and others alongwith their results. Faculty members are getting appreciation letter based on their performance.
- m. Different feedback is being taken from the students based on course delivery and facilities. Member secretary asked to present an action report based on the feedback.
- n. It was also discussed that action taken on the grievance by the students may be recorded and present in front of the members of Governing body, Member secretary assured for the same.
- o. After going to outcome of NBA accreditation of three programs, members shown their concern for not getting accreditation of CSE program, member secretary asked to submit necessary action taken by the institute.
- p. Members also discussed outcome of accreditation of different programs. It was discussed a letter is to be sent to RTU Kota with a comment made by accreditation team for week outcome though it was known RTU.
- q. Members took a visit of campus and advise that regular maintenance is required. Corrective action may be taken.
- r. Member secretary discussed the budget and the expenditure for the 2018-19 in brief. He informed that budget for the year 2018-19 was adequate.
- s. Budget for the 2019-20 was discussed. Member secretary informed that it will be submitted to the management for final approval.
- t. As per the outcome of NBA accreditation, academic audit is not proper, requested to take necessary action.
- u. In the month of April 2019 four international conferences were held and 120 papers were presented.
- v. Strategic planning of the institute for the next five years is presented and the approval of the same is received from the NSERD.
- w. IQAC is formed for NAAC application on dated 15/05/2019.
