When Dr Radhakrishnan took the office of the second President of India in 1962, his students approached him to seek permission to celebrate September 5 as a special day. Dr Radhakrishnan instead made a request of them to observe September 5 as Teachers' Day, to recognise the contribution of teachers to the society

Ever since then, September 5 is celebrated as Teacher's Day across schools,

annual celebrations at schools were replaced with virtual ones. With the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic and a threat of spreading, many colleges continue to operate their online classes.

Hence, virtual wishes and greetings are a perfect way to tell teachers you love and cherish them, even if you are no longer a school-college going student.

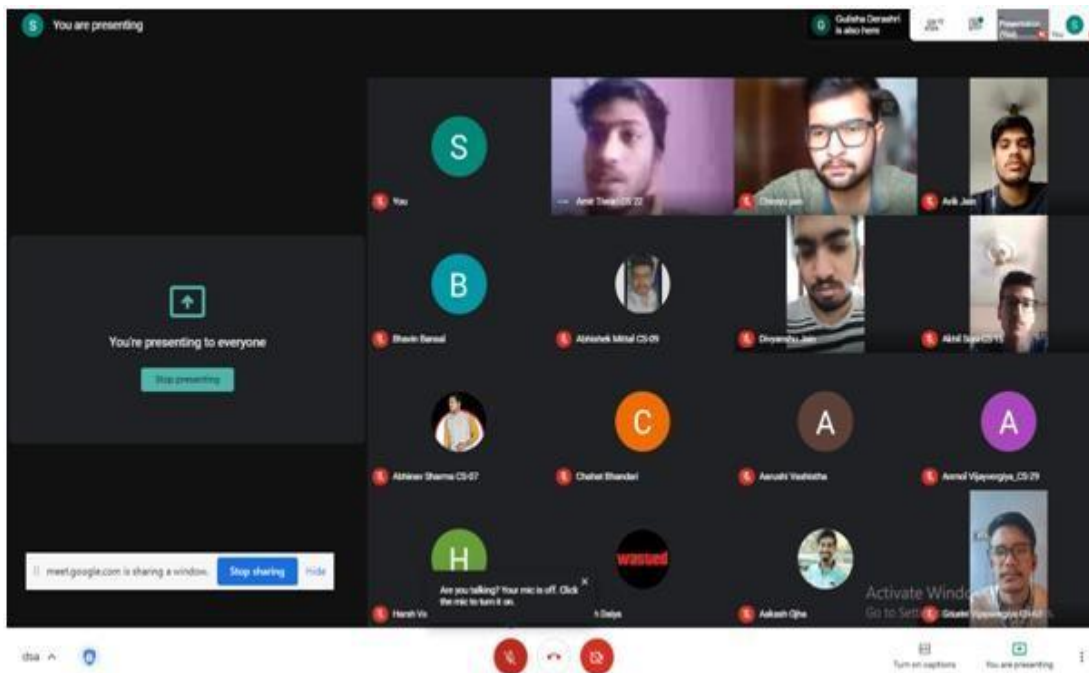
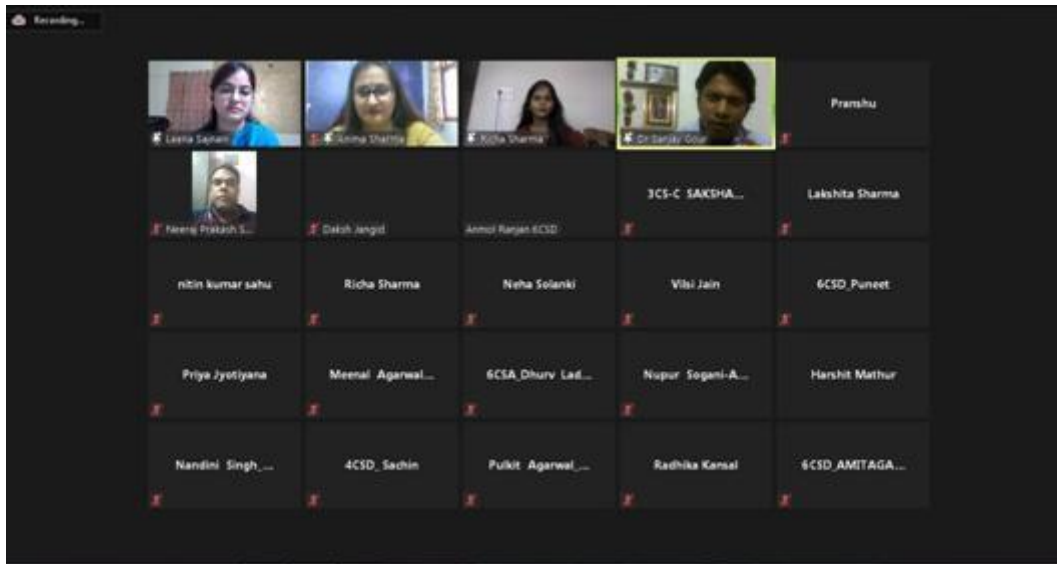

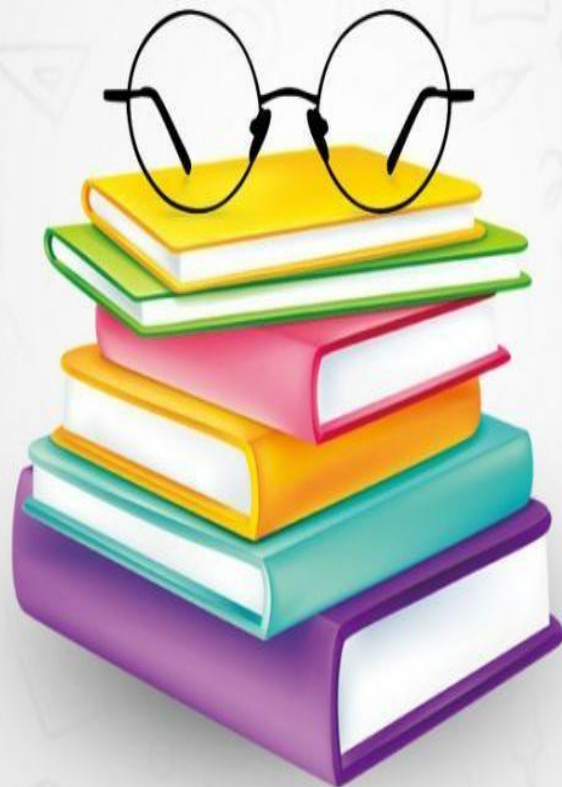
